



BOARD RESOLUTION

DISTRICT REORGANIZATION OF THE ST. LOUIS ARCHDIOCESAN COUNCIL

At the July 31, 2025, meeting of the Board of Directors of Society of St. Vincent de Paul Archdiocesan Council of St. Louis, the following recommendation was proposed and approved.

WHEREAS the Archdiocese of St. Louis reduced the number of parishes by approximately 25%; and

WHEREAS this reduction in parishes resulted in a similar reduction in SVdP Conferences; and

WHEREAS our Rule indicates District Councils should have a minimum of three Conferences and ideally a maximum of twelve (Part III, Statute 10); and

WHEREAS the Committee for District reorganization considered geography, Conference resources and finances, diversity, and community need to better organize our District Councils for the spiritual growth of our Vincentians and service to Christ through the poor;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors approves the proposed redistricting:

- The Festus District will be renamed to the Jerusalem District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Good Shepherd, Holy Family, Our Lady, Our Lady Queen of Peace, Mary Mother of the Church, Queen of All Saints, Sacred Heart (Crystal City), St. Anthony of Padua (High Ridge), St. John, St. Joseph (Imperial), St. Paul (Fenton), and St. Rose of Lima.
- The Gravois District will be renamed to the Bethel District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Assumption (South County), St. Gabriel the Archangel, St. Gerard Majella, St. Justin Martyr, St. Lucy, St. Peter (Kirkwood), St. Pius V, St. Raphael, St. Simon, and Seven Holy Founders.
- The Mid Central/North Central Districts will be renamed the Nazareth District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: All Souls, Annunziata, Cathedral Basilica, Christ the King, Immacolata, Little Flower, Our Lady of Lourdes (St. Louis), St. Ann (Normandy), St. Francis Xavier, St. Joseph (Clayton), St. Monica, and St. Roch.
- The North District will be renamed the Bethlehem District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Holy Name of Jesus, Incarnate Word, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Sacred Heart (Florissant), St. Angela Merici, St. Anselm, St. Charles Borromeo, St. Cletus, St. Ferdinand, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Norbert, St. Peter (St. Charles).
- The Northwest District will be renamed the Galilee District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: All Saints, Assumption (O'Fallon), Immaculate Conception (Dardenne Prairie), Immaculate Conception (Old Monroe), Immaculate Heart of Mary (New Melle), Sacred

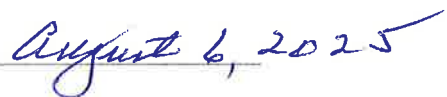
Heart (Elsberry), Sacred Heart (Troy), St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, St. Gianna, St. Joseph (Cottleville), St. Patrick, St. Paul (St. Paul), and St. Theodore.

- The South District will be renamed the Jericho District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Our Lady of Providence, St. Anthony of Padua (St. Louis), St. Catherine Laboure, St. Cecilia, St. Francis de Sales, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Mark, St. Martin of Tours, St. Stephen Protomartyr, and St. Wenceslaus.
- The South Central District will be renamed the Judea District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Ascension, Old Cathedral, Christ Prince of Peace, St. Ambrose, St. Clare of Assisi, St. Clement of Rome, St. Cronan, St. James the Greater, St. Mary Magdalen, and St. Peter Claver.
- The Southeast District will be renamed the Bethany District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Immaculate Conception (Park Hills), St. Agnes, St. James, St. Joachim, St. Joseph (Bonne Terre), St. Joseph (Farmington), St. Vincent de Paul (Perryville), Ste. Genevieve, and Ste. Marie Du Lac.
- The Southwest District will be renamed the Emmaus District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Annunciation, Epiphany of our Lord, Holy Infant, Holy Redeemer, Mary Queen of Peace, Sacred Heart (Valley Park), St. Joseph (Manchester), St. Margaret of Scotland, St. Michael the Archangel, St. Vincent de Paul (St. Louis), and St. Vincent de Paul (Young Adult).
- The West District will be renamed the Samaria District and will be comprised of the following Conferences: Holy Family and St. Gerald, Holy Rosary, Immaculate Conception (Union), Our Lady of Lourdes (Washington), Most Sacred Heart (Eureka), St. Alban Roe, St. Ann and St. Gertrude, St. Anthony and Holy Martyrs, St. Bridget of Kildare, St. Isidore, and St. James and St. Mary.
- The reorganization will occur on October 1, at the start of fiscal year 2026.
- Current District Presidents will continue to serve their terms, but may belong to a Conference outside of the District they serve. At the end of their term, a Vincentian from within the District will be elected the new District President.
- Based on redistricting, District Presidents may need to appoint new officers if the current officers are no longer in the District.
- To enable an easier transition to the new district names, through September 2026 the Districts will be referred to using a combination of the old name and new name. For example, "Gravois – Bethel" District.
