### **ABOUT THE COVER**

In 2022, catastrophic flooding caused by unprecedented rain hitting the St. Louis area resulted in a state of emergency. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul rose to meet this challenge to provide comfort and support for Neighbors who had been forced from their homes. The Society aided 1,000 families at Multi-Agency Relief Centers (MARCs) with empathy and prayer and material support such as food vouchers or Visa gift cards for immediate needs. The volunteer members of the Society then followed up with impacted Neighbors after the MARCs closed their doors — ensuring that those affected were well cared for during trying times.






