

New SVdP Resolutions from the Board

Dear Vincentians,

Greetings to all. We want to update you on Board resolutions about fiscal sustainability passed at last week's Board meeting.

These resolutions address:

 Changes in Council Program assistance: Council will assist with a maximum of one month rent/mortgage assistance and is temporarily pausing the Car Purchase & Repair Programs. Effective August 1, 2023.

• Changes to BDF funds: Districts will only receive BDF funds for special projects (such as a refrigerator for a food pantry). This will effectively end the 50-25-25 split. Effective August 1, 2023.

Additional Background on Resolutions

Several years ago, the Council was the beneficiary of a very generous bequest that allowed SVdP to provide significant financial support to Conferences for Neighbors.

Two things happened as a result:

- 1. Those funds have since been depleted. (This is a good thing! Afterall, the money given to SVdP belongs to the poor.)
- 2. Many Conferences (not all) have seen an increase in their treasuries because of the extra support provided to them by District and Council. The March CAR report balances indicated almost \$5 million in Conference funds. This money (unless restricted by the donor) should be used to serve our poor. The resolutions passed by the Board encourages this.

The Board Resolutions were approved to:

- 1. Encourage Vincentians to spend their Conference funds to help the poor.
- 2. Encourage Conferences to turn to twinning when more funds are needed. Your District President can assist with that.

Blessed Frederic Ozanam wrote to his mother in 1836:

"We have reason to hope that the (Society) will prosper. Indeed, when it was founded, it seemed to me a great folly, since we had only 180 francs. Providence has provided. I am now very much convinced that to do works of charity, it is never necessary to worry about pecuniary resources, they always come."

Safeguarding Requirements for Vincentian Members

Society of St. Vincent De Paul Archdiocesan Council (SVdP) seeks to ensure that, not only is abuse prevented and reported, but also works to create safe and respectful environments to protect the human dignity and confidentiality of our Neighbors-in-Need. Whether we visit with Neighbors or provide support for our conferences, as Vincentians it is important to know how to report abuse and support the Archdiocesan Code of Ethics.



Requirements:

All **NEW** Active and Associate Conference members must complete the Archdiocese Safe Environment Training Program within 14 days of joining a Conference and comply with the Archdiocesan updating requirements.

<u>Current</u> Active and Associate Conference members who have not yet completed the Archdiocese Safe Environment Training Program must do so before November 1, 2023, and report the relevant completion dates to their Conference President and the Council Office who will ensure the information is entered into the Member ServWare page.

The Training Program is all online and easy to complete in just 20-30 minutes.
