New Rolled-Bed Update! Available Now!







The new Tanda Rolled Beds are available now at all St. Louis store locations, and displays can be viewed at most store locations.

The two exceptions are Ballwin and Creve Coeur, where limited inventory will still be available, but not on display.

Stores each received between 5-15 sets of the "new" beds to start with and will begin receiving inventory weekly on Monday, 1/8.

The picture above shows the compact size of the rolled bed with a person for scale. One person can easily lift and carry this mattress alone!

Because they come tightly rolled and are relatively light weight, many neighbors will now be able to pick up these new beds without the need for delivery!

The bedframes also fold down small enough to fit in many vehicles.

Help Neighbors Escape

Helping Neighbors Trapped in High-Interest Loans

The St. Louis Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) and Midwest BankCentre have teamed up to launch the Credit Empowerment Pilot Program to assist Neighbors who are trapped in high-interest loans from payday, car title, or other high-cost lenders. The program will replace up to \$3,000 in high-interest loans with a Credit Empowerment loan from Midwest BankCentre at 6.43%. Midwest BankCentre will also provide periodic financial coaching during the term of the Credit Empowerment loan.

To be eligible, a Neighbor must be capable of paying back the Credit Empowerment Ioan in 6-24 months. An SVDP Credit Empowerment Team member will meet with the Neighbor to prepare a budget and verify that the Neighbor's monthly income exceeds monthly expenses, once the high-interest payment is replaced by the low-interest payment. Thus far, the high-interest rates encountered by this program have ranged from 132% to 690%. A Neighbor with a 12-month \$2,500 loan at 330% could save more than \$500 a month and \$6,000 in total by converting to a Credit Empowerment loan.

If you are a Neighbor with a high-interest loan, please contact your local SVDP Conference, which you can locate by visiting bit.ly/SVDPhelp and following the instructions. Please note that loan closing must be in person. Midwest BankCentre has branches in St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Jefferson County, and St. Charles County.

If you are a Vincentian and would like your Conference to participate in the program, or if you are an individual interested in becoming a Credit Empowerment Team member (i.e., meeting with Neighbors to prepare budgets and help assess eligibility), please contact credit@svdpstl.org, and a Zoom training session will be scheduled at your convenience.
