SVdP Rapid Rehousing Expanding to More Districts!

With approval from the Board of Directors, the Housing Task Force plans to expand the Rapid Rehousing Pilot to Jefferson, St. Francois, and Ste. Genevieve Counties. The pilot will continue to serve Neighbors in St. Louis City and County. Rapid Rehousing is available for Neighbors who are at risk of homelessness or who have been homeless for 30 days or less. Conferences who want to refer neighbors to the program MUST participate in a Zoom Training session. These trainings will be for Vincentians in Jefferson, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve Counties. Vincentians from St. Louis City and County who would like a refresher or who have not yet participated are also welcome to join.
