From the Voice of the Poor

Benefits Cliff Legislation Awaiting Governor's Signature

During the last session, the Missouri legislature passed benefits cliff legislation as an amendment to SB 45/90, a bill that also expands Medicaid for post-partum women from 60 days to one year.



Instead of cutting off benefits altogether when an income threshold is reached, SB 45/90 provides for gradually reduced SNAP, TANF, and childcare benefits as a recipient's income increases to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, or approximately \$60,000 for a family of four.

Governor Parson has until mid-July to sign the bill, veto it, or take no action. Please consider contacting the Governor and urging him to sign SB 45/90. If he takes no action, the bill still becomes law.

The benefits cliff legislation was passed "subject to appropriation", meaning that there will be more work next session to secure funding for the program.

Assuming SB 45/90 becomes law, stay tuned for more action alerts in 2024 regarding funding.

Credit Empowerment Pilot Program Launched

In April, the St. Louis Council launched a Credit Empowerment Pilot Program with Midwest BankCentre.

For eligible Neighbors with existing high-interest loans, Midwest BankCentre will (1) convert the Neighbor's high-interest loan to a low-interest loan secured by an SVDP Certificate of Deposit, and (2) coach the Neighbor on credit and money management periodically through the term of the loan.

On June 8, the first Neighbor in the pilot closed on a 6.43% APR loan at Midwest BankCentre that replaced her two high-interest loans with APRs of 358% and 246%.

To be eligible for the pilot, Neighbors must owe \$500 - \$3,000 on high-interest loan(s) from a payday, car title, or high-cost installment loan lender, have monthly income that exceeds monthly expenses (once expenses are adjusted for lower loan payments), and agree to periodic financial coaching.

A Credit Empowerment Team comprised of Vincentians with financial backgrounds assesses Neighbors' eligibility and walks them through the loan process.

Nine Conferences are currently participating in the pilot, and we are seeking up to three additional Conferences to participate. The role of the Conference is to identify that the Neighbor has a high-interest loan, confirm the Neighbor has compiled the documents needed for the budgeting meeting with the Credit Empowerment Team, and for approved Neighbors, follow up monthly during the term of the loan to ensure nothing has arisen to prevent loan repayment.

Since in-person visits to the bank are required, pilot Conferences should be located within a reasonable distance of one of the four participating Midwest BankCentre branches: Hazelwood, Pagedale, Chesterfield, and Lemay.

The pilot will last approximately one year, after which a decision will be made on whether to expand. For more information, please email credit@svdpstl.org or call Mary Kreienkamp at 314-852-2305.
