

Do you have Neighbors who want to gain control of their money, reduce debt, build credit, free themselves from predatory loans, or refinance high-interest car loans? Two recent Council webinars described the free services available to Neighbors throughout the Archdiocese that can help them do all that and more! The Financial Empowerment Resources for Vincentians webinar on October 25th of last year discussed the services offered through Prosperity Connection, Operation HOPE, Justine PETERSEN, and our Council's own Credit Empowerment Pilot Program.
