# Potential Vincentian Tickler Questions

Use this list of tickler questions during the first Conference Meeting of your recruiting campaign. Begin the meeting with the Prayer and Reflection and then go through this list of questions as a group with all of the members at the meeting. Go through the questions slowly enough for the members to think about the questions and respond with names that come to mind, but keep it moving. Some questions will generate multiple names, others might not generate any names at all. Just collect names - there is no need for further discussion or explanation of why they are recommended at this point. Members should just call out names as they come to mind. Record every name that is called out on the Campaign Tracker form.

Category	Questions
<b>Conference/Parish/ Community</b>	Are there Associate members of our Conference who we can encourage to become Full members?
	Does anyone come to mind who used to be an active member who could be encouraged to re-activate?
	Are there any individuals who expressed interest in the past but didn't become active who we can follow up with and invite again?
	Who are the standout families in our parish community - are there members of those families who we could invite to be Vincentians?
<b>Family Members/Friends/ Acquaintances</b>	Are there family members of our members (e.g. spouse, brothers and sisters, grown children) who we can invite to join?
	Do I have good friends who are not Vincentians? Can I invite them to experience what I experience as a Vincentian?
	Of all the people I know, who is most like me when I became a Vincentian?
	Who have I thought I could ask to be a Vincentian - but then I decided they wouldn't because of...?

<b>Passionate/ Compassionate/ Generous</b>	Who are the most thoughtful and compassionate individuals in our parish community?
	Who are individuals in our parish community that are: always taking care of others? passionate about Justice? committed to helping the poor? very generous with their time? very generous with their talents?
<b>Spirituality/Ministries</b>	Who belongs to my (Bible Study, Book Club, PTA, Athletic Association, Liturgy Committee, etc.) that could be a Vincentian?
	Who have I made a retreat with who could be a Vincentian?
	Who are the individuals in our parish that are: active in our Adoration community? admirably and visibly living out their faith? striving to grow in their own spiritual life? striving to help others grow in their spiritual life? very prayerful?
<b>Evangelizers/New Openness</b>	Who are the individuals in our parish community that are bearing suffering in their lives (divorce, death of loved one, employment insecurity, etc.) particularly well?
	Who are the individuals in our parish that are: good evangelizers? very social, that love to be with others, but are experiencing isolation with the pandemic? very active - you see them at all of the parishes activities? usually ready to share and openly talk about their faith?
<b>Personal Interest/Topics</b>	Who are the individuals in our parish community that really want to "Make a Difference?"
	Who are individuals in our parish community that: I would love to make a Home Visit with because of their personality or abilities? have great initiative and get things done? have good ingenuity and are problem solvers?
	Who are individuals in our parish community that are: extremely joyful? very good listeners? great story-tellers?
<b>Other</b>	Are there any other individuals we should invite to join our society whose name hasn't been mentioned?
