1. Opening Reflection

Elizabeth Barbieri provided a reflection on St. John Neumann, whose feast day was celebrated on this day.

2. United Way

Elizabeth reviewed pros and cons of being a United Way agency and receiving United Way funding. This included a written summary from John Foppe plus input from several others.

The Board discussed various negatives. There have been conflicts with the Catholic faith, campaigns for employee participation, United Way agents who struggle to understand SVdP's federated structure, a fund raising black-out period, time and opportunities that are lost, and a declining value in branding as a United Way agency.

On the positive side, there was strong interest to retain a relationship with the United Way for 211 referrals, emergency response, and other community collaboration. A change in the agency status should be communicated diplomatically, noting that the funds can be used by other agencies in need. The change could bring new support for SVdP from certain

corporate foundations. The change may be of interest to the Archdiocese for their consideration, noting benefits that SVdP is finding. For the long term, SVdP still has options to pursue an agency status, should circumstances change.

MOTION: The Board approved a proposal to discontinue being a United Way agency.
