#### 2. Florissant Store

Mike Goering discussed a proposed relocation of the Florissant Store. The existing location is doing well on various metrics. It provides good services for the community. A new location in the area will provide better visibility and will be a good fit. A higher lease payment would be absorbed due to the commercial viability. The Finance Committee reviewed and recommended this relocation.

**RESOLUTION:** The Board approved a resolution to move the Florissant Store to 770 N. Highway 67, Florissant, Missouri.

#### 3. Dellwood Store

Mike Goering discussed the situation with the Dellwood Store. The store has had declining voucher volume. It has not reached financial expectations. The Cool Valley Thrift Outlet Store and Florissant Thrift Store are in the general area. The Finance Committee reviewed a proposal and recommends closing the Dellwood Store.

**RESOLUTION:** The Board approved a resolution to cease operations of the Dellwood Store at 10052 W. Florissant Avenue, Dellwood, Missouri.
